- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The involved institutions may agree on the procedure of modifying or terminating the bilateral agreement. In case of unilateral modification or termination, a written notice of at least one academic year ahead will be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
