- 4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement will come into effect for the whole period of the ERASMUS+Programme until 2020, unless one of the institutions informs the other in writing, six
months before the start of the academic year, of their intention to withdraw.
The partners in the agreement will consult each other as often as necessary, at least
once a year, in order to evaluate their cooperation. Any alteration to the present
agreement of cooperation must be consented to by authorized bodies of both
institutions.

Details of this agreement may be altered as a result of the experience acquired by both institutions and developments in their respective course programs.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
